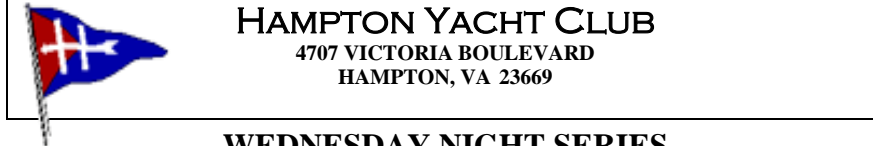

DATES: Every Wednesday night, April 1 through September 30.

ENTRIES: Submit a standard CBYRA entry and crew registration form for the series or race to Hampton Yacht Club, 4707 Victoria Boulevard, Hampton, VA 23669.

RULES: CCV Sailing Instructions apply except as modified by this circular.

STARTING SYSTEM: RRS 26


ORDER OF STARTS: PHRF N2 Warning 1800
PHRF N1
PHRF C
PHRF B / A


* N2 All Cruising and others rated 155 and up. ** N1 Boats rated 154 and below.


STARTING LINE: CCV Mark "A" (See back CCV marks)


FINISH LINE: Mark "A" or off the HYC docks, "F", Race Committee's option. **(RCs are urged to take finishes at "A" unless it is clearly a free leg up the creek.)**


COURSES:

Course A: ("A" Flag ) Marks "E", "T", "C", "P", "B", "A".

Course B: ("F" Flag ) Marks "B", "P", "C", "T", "I", "A".

Course C: ("E" Flag ) Marks "E" (leave to port), "A".

Course D: ("D" Flag ) Mark "N" (leave to port), "A".

Course E: (Green Flag ) Marks "I", "T", "E" (leave to starboard), "A".

When entering Hampton Creek honor "G13", "R14".

CLASS FLAGS: Please fly your class flags. PHRF N classes will not need to fly Code 1 or Code 2 flags. Inexperienced (Cruising) boats may fly a white flag or streamer from their backstay to signify to other racers that the Cruiser may have limited race experience and knowledge of the racing rules. Please assist and encourage these newcomers.

CANCELLATION: If the Race Committee is a "no show" by 1800, it is requested that boats on the scene choose a start boat and proceed with the normal sequence. If severe weather is predicted or occurs early in the race, please stay at or return to the dock.

TIME LIMIT: 30 minutes after sunset.

AWARDS: The pleasure of a late afternoon sail and sociability with friends and companions.

PROTESTS: Despite the informality of the series, all races will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2013-2016*. Should a formal protest be necessary, a written protest must be delivered to the RC Chairperson for that night within 30 minutes of the protesting boat finishing. Protests will be handled as soon as possible following the race. A Protest Committee will consist of the RC Chairperson for the night plus two others of his choosing.

PENALTIES: Results of protest hearings will be regarded as educational to the extent that is possible. Repeated offenses will lead to a request not to participate further in the series.

RESULTS: Corrected time calculations will not be made by the Race Committee. However, an Order-of-Finish sheet with finish times will be posted in the lounge following racing.

SOCIAL: Hampton Yacht Club welcomes registered participating race crews to the Club following the races. Visiting yachts may tie up at the Club piers without charge until 10:00 p.m., subject to space available.

Visitors are expected to behave in a manner appropriate to their status as guests, including adherence to House Rules, which include:

* No food, beer, wine, or liquor may be brought into the Club.

* Shirts and shoes are required in the Bar.

* Dining Room attire is expected to be somewhat more decorous than that tolerated in the Bar. T-shirts and tank tops are not allowed. On the other hand, coats and ties are not required. We try for neatness.

PARKING: Only members of HYC who have valid parking decals may park in the HYC lots. Violators are subject to towing.
