

## HYC CUP – 2018

### Update # 1

Two races are in the books for the 2018 HYC CUP Championship and Ian Hill's *Sitella* sits alone atop the standings with six points. *Sitella* has taken the proven road to the top of the leader board through participation (doing both Down the Bay and Southern Bay Race Week) and excellence (winning a very tough Down the Bay A Fleet). However, several other boats are also well positioned following the spring season with five boats tied for second with five points, one of which is Neil and Lis Ford's defending champion Danger Paws. Eight more boats are close behind with four points, including 2016 Champion Callinectes (Ben Cuker).
