This regatta will be sailed in the harbor off Strawberry Banks using HYC Sonars.

Three windward/leeward races will be attempted, wind and weather permitting.

Boat and crew assignments will be done at the Skippers Meeting Saturday morning.

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- **2.1** The regatta will be open to all HYC women members or women participating in the HYC Women's Sailing Program.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the HYC website and distributed at the Skippers Meeting.

5 RACING PROGRAM

- **5.1** Racing will be conducted off Strawberry Banks at the mouth of the Hampton River.
- **5.2** Courses will be drop mark windward/leewards, twice around. See Appendix A.
- **5.3** Three short races will be attempted, wind and weather permitting.

Target time for each race = 30-35 mins.

6 SCORING

There will be no throw-outs. One race will constitute a regatta.

7 AWARDS

Appropriate awards will be presented at the Post-Race Awards Party in the HYC lounge.

8 RADIO

Each boat is encouraged to have a hand-held VHF radio aboard. The Race Committee will make courtesy announcements regarding such things as starting information, postponements, as well as attempt to hail boats who are OCS.

9 SAFETY

All participants must wear a Coast Guard approved type 3.5 PFD. The PFDs must be worn and secured any time a participant is in the Sonar.
