YACHT REQUIRMENTS: All PHRF boats must have a current PHRF valid certificate.

Cruising Fleet boats will be given a courtesy rating by the race committee.

All boats must meet US Sailing Nearshore Safety Equipment Requirements (which are posted at the HYC website).

STARTING LINE: In the vicinity of CCV Harbor Mark "H" (R N "20") off Hampton Flats.
The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the RC Signal Boat and the adjacent government or drop mark.

FINISH LINE: Between the staff displaying an orange flag on RC Signal Boat and the nearby mark designated by the posted course, unless the course has been shortened.

COURSES: As per the CCV General Sailing Instructions. One mark must be Middle Ground Light.

STARTING SYSTEM: RRS 26.

TIME LIMIT: Any boat not finished within 3.5 hours of its fleet's start will be scored DNF.

PROTESTS: Due: In writing within one hour of the Race Committee arriving at the HYC dock. Protests will be heard at 1900 hours on Monday, September 9th at HYC, unless heard earlier by mutual agreement.

SOCIAL: Crabs, beer, and soft drinks will be provided to skippers and crew on the HYC dock after the race.

AWARDS: Appropriate awards will be presented at the HYC Annual Awards Night on December 3rd. Also, the Leon James Trophy (Best corrected time in A Fleet) and the Barry August Trophy (Best corrected time in Non-Spin) will be presented.

This race counts toward the HYC CUP Championship.
